Hazards identification

Harmful by inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed. Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin.

3. Composition

4-t-butyl-2-isopropylphenol
CAS-nr: 95 %

4. First aid measures

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. In case of contact, immediately wash skin with soap and copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. If inhaled remove to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If swallowed, wash out mouth with water provided person is conscious. Call a physician. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

5. Fire fighting measures

Extinguishing media: Water spray, carbon dioxide, dry chemical powder or appropriate foam.

Unusual hazards: Emits toxic fumes of nitrogen oxides.

6. Accidental release measures

Wear respirator, chemical safety goggles, rubber boots and heavy rubber gloves. Sweep up, place in a bag and hold for disposal.
Ventilate area and wash spill site after material pick up is complete.

7. Handling and storage

All handling of dangerous chemicals should be performed in a hood or well ventilated area.

Store in a tightly closed container in a dry, dark place.

8. Exposure control / personal protection

Work in a well ventilated areas. Use chemical safety goggles and compatible chemical resistant gloves. Use suitable respirator. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid prolonged and repeated exposure. Wash thoroughly after handling.

9. Physical and chemical properties

Yellowish liquid.

10. Stability and reactivity

Incompatible with strong oxidizing agents.

11. Toxicological information

Harmful by inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed. Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin.

Dissolve or mix the material with a combustible solvent and burn in a chemical incinerator equipped with an afterburner and a scrubber. Observe all federal, state and local environmental regulations.
